(Men's and Women's) ITEM (Option To Advance)	NFHS No Rule	NYSGBOA <u>Upon a timeout under 59.9 seconds in fourth or extra period when the ball in the backcourt is out of bounds, after a made basket, or after a change of possession (no dribble or pass), offense may choose to advance to frontcourt 28-foot line tableside or opposite for ensuing throw-in.</u>
Arm Bar in Post	May be used if post player does not have ball	May be used if post player does or does not have ball. No displacement allowed. If post player turns and faces basket, she becomes a ball handler and all hands or arm bars must come down.

Double Foul	Point of interruption for all double fouls	If differing in severity, both penalties assessed with most severe last. Throw in at Division Line

Time Outs Number	Four 60 Second Time Outs & two 30 Second Time Outs. One 30 second T.O. per half.	<u>Four 60 Second Time Outs & 2 – 30 Second Time Outs. All time outs may carry over from 1st to 2nd half.</u>
Overtime	1 additional 60 second time out plus remaining time outs from regulation.	<u>1 additional 30 second time out plus remaining time outs from regulation.</u>
Request	Recognized when a player is in control.	Officials should not recognize time out request when an airborne players' momentum carries her out of bounds or into the BC.
Officials Positioning During T.O.	Calling Official- 30 second, Tableside of center circle 60 second, non-table side of center circle. Non-Calling Official- Spot of Throw In for both 30 and 60 second T.O.	30 Second T.O. Both officials should be at the top of the key, one at either end. 60 second T.O. Both officials should be on the lowest block, one at either end. Inbounding official should have ball.
